

# GRAND CHAPTER OF KANSAS ORDER OF THE EASTERN STAR

- a. Applicants must be US citizens and Residents of Kansas.
- b. Applicants must be full-time on campus students enrolled in twelve (12) hours or more per semester at an accredited, brick and mortar institution of higher education with its main campus located in Kansas. This includes: Community Colleges, Fouryear accredited colleges or universities or Vocational/Technical/Trade Schools in the State of Kansas.
- c. Kansas Masonic affiliation, as defined below, is a requirement for all but the Hendricks and Cearley Youth Scholarships. Definition: Master Masons and Members of the Eastern Star, Children and Grandchildren of Masons and/or Members of the Eastern Star in Kansas; Also, current or Majority Members of the youth groups (DeMolay, Job's Daughters, Rainbow Girls) shall be eligible to receive scholarship awards.
- d. Students may be eligible for more than one scholarship. Awards will be made at the discretion of the Scholarship Board within the stipulations of each individual Scholarship Fund to best utilize the monies available each year.
- e. Applications being mailed to the Grand Chapter Office c/o Executive Secretary are to be postmarked on or before June 15 with proper postage. With mail service as it is, it is suggested that the application be mailed "Certified Mail with Return Receipt" with CORRECT POSTAGE for proof of mailing. To confirm receipt of application at the Grand Chapter office, email: **oes-ks@sbcglobal.net**. If an application with all documents is given directly to the Grand Secretary on or before June 15, be sure to ask for a confirmation of receipt. If an application with all documents are taken directly to the Grand Chapter Office on or before June 15, it is the responsibility of the applicant to arrange drop off during open hours at the Grand Chapter Office as it has limited days and hours of operation. Email: **oes-ks@sbcglobal.net** in advance to make arrangements to deliver the documents. When delivering the documents, be sure to ask for a confirmation of receipt.

### It is suggested that each applicant retain a copy of all documents.

# \*\*Electronic submissions of applications WILL NOT be accepted at this time. Applications are at NO TIME to be mailed or given to anyone other than the methods listed above.

#### Rules adopted by the O.E.S. Scholarship Board

- I. Students must attest to their Masonic or OES relationship (Parent, Grand Parent, or Member themselves of a Lodge, Chapter or Youth Group in Kansas) and be prepared to present credentials of verification.
- II. Applicants must submit a completed application for Scholarship(s), with all supporting documents, to the Executive Secretary by June 15: Mailed with a postmark to the Grand Chapter Office on or before June 15; OR given directly to the Grand Chapter Secretary by June 15; OR hand delivered to the Grand Chapter Office during open hours by June 15. \*No electronic submissions will be accepted\*. (Rev. 1/24/2023)
- III. Awards are made annually to begin in the fall semester. Scholarship amounts may vary, depending upon the availability of funds, unless specified in the scholarship description. Applicants will be notified of awards by letter prior to the fall semester. No recipient will receive awards more than four years.
- IV. Awards will be mailed to the school in the name of both the student and the institution. One half of the award will be mailed for the fall semester, the balance to be mailed for the spring semester. It is the student's responsibility to contact the Financial Aid Office at his/her institution to receive the award. In the event a student cannot matriculate the second semester, that portion of the scholarship shall be returned to the Grand Chapter of Kansas and the Scholarship Fund upon which it was drawn.



### Available Scholarships and Eligibility Kansas Masonic and/or Eastern Star Affiliation is required for all <u>EXCEPT</u> the Cearley and Hendricks Scholarships.

#### **O.E.S.** Scholarships

Availability of funds will determine the number and the amounts of scholarships awarded.

# Juniors and Seniors

#### **Dorothy C. Cooper Scholarship**

Students who have completed their first two (2) years of study at a junior college or a four (4) year college who plan to continue their education at one of the 2 or 4 year college or Universities as per in item (b) above.

Juniors must have a minimum of 60 credit hours, Seniors must have a minimum of 90 credit hours. A student who received an award in their Junior year, may re-apply for their Senior year.

It is hoped the two scholarships can be awarded each year, depending upon the availability of funds.

#### Frances M. Farr Memorial Scholarship

Students who have completed their first two years of study at a junior college or a four-year college may apply. Juniors must have a minimum of 60 credit hours, Seniors must have a minimum of 90 credit hours. Students who received an award in their Junior year, may re-apply for their Senior year.

#### Jerry K. VanAllen Memorial Scholarship

Students who have completed their first two years of study at a Junior/Community or four-year College/University and are continuing their education at any accredited four-year College or University in Kansas are eligible for the Jerry K. VanAllen Memorial Scholarship.

Awards should be based on financial need with service, leadership and scholastic standing also to be considered factors.

Students who receive an award their Junior year may re-apply for their Senior year.

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## Freshmen – Seniors Graham Chapter #395 Scholarship

Students in their Freshman through Senior year may apply for this scholarship to be used at a Kansas institution of higher education.. Students may reapply for up to four years. Scholarship amount depends upon the availability of funds.

#### Faith M. Snyder Scholarship

Students in their Freshman through Senior year may apply for this scholarship to be used at a Kansas institution of higher education... Students may re-apply for up to four years. Scholarship amount depends upon the availability of funds.

#### Fern Chapter #107 Scholarship

Students in their Freshman through Senior year may apply for this scholarship to be used at a Kansas institution of higher education... Students may re-apply for up to four years. Scholarship amount depends upon the availability of funds.

#### Elnita Jezek Memorial Scholarship

Students in their Freshman thru Senior year may apply for the Scholarship to be used at a Kansas institution of higher education. Students may re-apply for up to four years. Read

(b) for eligibility.

A \$1,000.00 Scholarship will be awarded each year.

#### Specialty Scholarships Mary & Melvin Grubb Medical Scholarship

Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, or Senior students at the University of Kansas School of Medicine. (Pre-Med or Graduate Students are not eligible.) Applicants may apply each year (*but not more than four times*). Awards will be made based upon scholastic standing and personal need. Amount depends upon availability of funds.

#### **Seniors Only**

#### The Eugene S. & Arvilla U. Parker Scholarship

Only students at Kansas State University having completed their Junior year, having accumulated at least 90 credit hours, may apply for this scholarship to be used for their Senior year of schooling.

A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded.

# Rose Shumaker Scholarship for Medical Technician or Nursing Education

Students pursuing a degree in Nursing or studying to become a Medical Technician may apply in their Freshman through Senior year. Students may re-apply for up to four years.

A \$500 scholarship to be awarded, depending upon the availability of funds.

# Ruth Cearley Memorial Scholarship

Must be a member of a Masonic Youth Group

High School Seniors, or college students, who are currently active in their respective youth organization are eligible. The award is to be used toward either junior college or four-year college training. This award is open to members of the three Masonic Youth Groups on an annual rotating basis: Rainbow for Girls (2016-2017), DeMolay (2017-2018), Job's Daughters (2018-2019).

Applicants must include a letter of verification of youth group membership from their youth leader. The award is 500.00.

#### Danny Hendricks Memorial Scholarship No affiliation is Required

Any High School Senior who will be attending Kansas institution of higher education. The scholarship will be awarded based on financial need with preference given to students whose family cannot otherwise afford college tuition. Recipients may apply for up to four years.

The amount of the award depends upon the availability of funds, up to \$1,000.00.
