Their inquiry

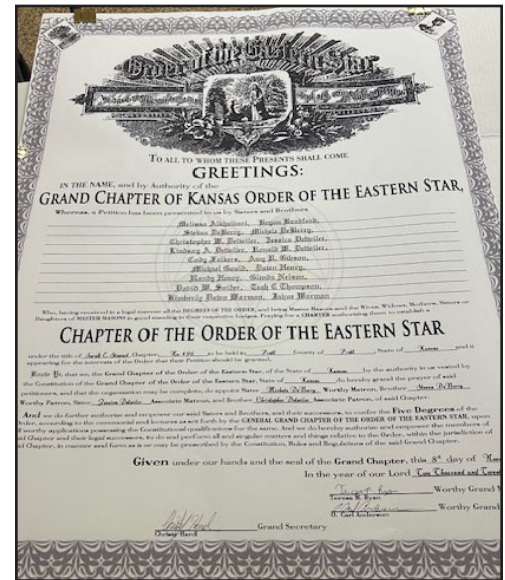

White Rose #297, Gridley

On October 25, 2025, White Rose Chapter #297, Gridley and Hebron Lodge #314, Gridley had a fundraiser to help one of our members to get a Service Dog for their daughter who is 5 years old. She is the daughter of Laci & Zach Hansen and granddaughter of Sharon Ryan. Both Laci and Sharon are members of White Rose Chapter #297. Their daughter, Adalyn has been having seizures since she was a baby. The seizures occur mostly in the overnight, early morning, waking hours 3:30 am to 6:30 am. Her seizures are considered refractory and if not treated early, very often progress to status epilepticus. A seizure alert dog will be huge in assuring they are awoken immediately upon a seizure occurring so they can treat it as soon as possible. Not only will this dog be used for seizure alert, but mobility assistance and deep pressure therapy to help her in

anxious situations, providing her a little independence.

The fundraiser was very successful, raising over \$8,300.00. A check for \$6,409.00 was presented to the family on November 10 during their Official visit of Teresa Ryan, WGM and Carl Anderson, WGP. More money was received later from other Chapters and \$1500.00 was received by the Lodge's matching funds from the Masonic Foundation. The family is very grateful to the support of the community and other Chapters around the state that helped in this fundraiser. Thank you to all that participated.

The Star Gazer is published quarterly, normally in June, September, December, and March. Actual publishing dates may vary, depending on circumstances.

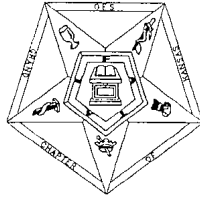
Distribution of the newsletter is primarily through electronic means. Paper copies of the newsletter are available upon request.
